**How are our children progressing academically?**

This week we have been meeting with teachers and discussing the progress all the children are making. If we are concerned about a child's progress we discuss what support we can offer the child to ensure they quickly get back on track. Teachers will have discussed with you during parents evening how your child is progressing and what can be done to support them. We are thrilled to report that our current whole school results are looking very strong:

Our teachers are working extremely hard to ensure children are achieving and our parent survey shows you also recognise this with 99% of parents surveyed saying their child makes good progress at Bexton.

We know parents at Bexton share our high expectations and we thank you for your support. Whilst academic results are important we also pride ourselves on the fact children are very happy at Bexton. A wonderful 99% of parents surveyed say that their child is happy at Bexton.
