Need to know:

<u>Sports Week:</u> Mr Evans has written to parents to let them know all the information about sports week and the agenda. We've given an abbreviated version below. They key information all parents need to know is that uniform is sportswear all week (except Y4 @Cheshire Show) and that children will be spending more time outside so to make sure children come to school with hats, sun cream and water bottles. Medium Term Plans & Sex Education (Jigsaw): All of the summer 2 medium term plans have been uploaded to each year group page and to this page. Measles Cases

UKHSA has reported an increase in measles across the country and is encouraging people to check that they and their children have had two doses of the MMR vaccine. If children and young adults have missed these vaccinations in the past, they can get the vaccine now from GPs, particularly in light of the recent cases. Anyone with symptoms is advised to stay at home and phone their GP/NHS 111 for advice.

Measles symptoms include:

- high fever
- sore, red, watery eyes
- coughing
- aching and feeling generally unwell
- a blotchy red brown rash, which usually appears after the initial symptoms
