<u>Change of infant school times</u>: To clarify some points from last week's newsletter, following a <u>directive from the government</u> that states all mainstream primary aged children should be in school for a minimum of 32.5 hrs per week from September 2023, we have unfortunately had to change the

length of day for our infant department. Timings will now align with the junior department with doors opening from 8:40am (registration at 8:50am) and home time at 3:20pm. We are aware this may affect morning waiting times for those families who have children in the Nursery and will therefore be sensitive to this during inclement weather by opening doors earlier where needed. We hope that this will ease traffic around school as the vast majority of parents won't be waiting as long and will now be able to 'drop and go.'
