How can FOBS help me?

Meet lots of other parents from across your child's year group, and the whole school, by volunteering together. You'll also meet lots of the teachers, who do lots to help with events. Whether you can spare 30 minutes to help at an event, contribute some ideas or resources, or organise an event yourself with friends. We welcome more diversity and would love to hear from mums, dads, grandparents, extended family and friends.

They may also request volunteers, but the reps themselves will not necessarily be in charge of organising the events.

What is "FOBS"?

Friends of Bexton was formally the name of the parent teachers association at our school. Since [2020], FOBS is no longer a separate entity and we do not have a PTA style committee. Instead, FOBS refers to any parents, teachers and friends of the school who fundraise on behalf of the school. The school is a registered charity.

What is the purpose of FOBS?

Our purpose is to raise additional money for school, support our teachers in providing fun and meaningful experiences for our children and to encourage families to get together and enjoy being part of the Bexton community.

What is the money raised by FOBS being used for?

These funds are critical to pay for "additional extras" that the school wouldn't normally be able to afford. Last year, FOBS raised £10,164.69.For example, last year FOBS paid for the new outdoor canopies outside the classroom doors, a new sound system for the hall & road signs to protect the children outside the school grounds.

How is FOBS organised?

All parents and friends of the school are invited to attend a FOBS planning meeting in September each year to get ideas for fundraising and social events. The events will be run by volunteer parents from different year groups, to share out the organisation. As we have up to 60 families per year group, this is a great opportunity for volunteers to meet other parents and for new parents to get involved.
