We are delighted to inform you that Mr Roberts, our sports coach will be in school three days a week from now on. We have been able to do this due to an increase in the sports funding from the government.

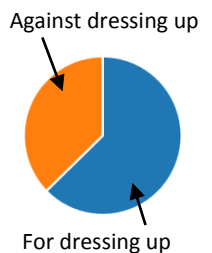
