



Primary PE and sports premium

The government is continuing to provide additional funding for the academic year 2017/18 to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary schools. This funding is provided with the aim to:

- Develop or add to the PE and sport activities that school already offers
- Build capacity and capability within school to ensure that improvements now will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.

There are five key indicators that schools should expect to see improvements across:

- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity (recommended at least 60 minutes per day of which 30 minutes should be in school)
- The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
- Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- Increased participation in competitive sport

KSSP fees	£1375	- To give all children an opportunity to compete against other children from the local primary schools.
MSSP fees	£500	- To give children (particularly the more able and G&T children) an opportunity to compete against a wider range of pupils from the county at a higher level. This will also allow us to apply for the School Games award for this academic year.
Staff CPD & Coaching EYFS, KS1 & KS2	£10,293	- Our sports coach from PE&Sport Hub will continue to work with staff to provide high quality PE lessons for all Bexton children from Nursery to Year 6. His expertise will not only give staff more knowledge and confidence to teach a wider range of sports, but will help to enthuse the children and encourage them to love sport and lead an active lifestyle.

We will now be using last year's data to inform future planning and to target children that are not making progress or engaging in physical activity on a regular basis.</li> </ul>
