

Bexton Test Results 2018



The schools' most recent key stage results

The first table shows the percentage of Year 6 pupils at Bexton Primary School achieving each level, compared to national end of Key Stage 2 results. All results are test results, except writing which is teacher assessed. Our results across the school are above or well above national averages.
