

SHOULD I CLAIM FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS FOR MY CHILD?



DO YOU RECEIVE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING?



- Universal Credit with no earned income or with net monthly earnings less than £616.67
- Income Support
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income related Employment Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit - as long as you have a yearly household income of less than £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) and do not get Working Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)



If you can answer YES to any of these above, your child may qualify for the Pupil Premium.

This means they could receive:

- Free school meals up to Year 6
- Some additional academic or social support in class
- Free extra-curricular clubs*
- Subsidised trips and residential visits.*
