Mental Health Awareness Week

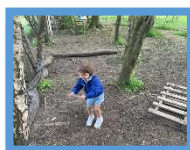
This week we are marking Mental Health Awareness week by learning about the work of a charity, Boys in Mind (BiM). Boys in Mind are a charity whose mission is to empower children and young people, particularly boys and young men to talk about their emotions and express their vulnerability in a safe and healthy manner; helping to create a society where everyone is accepted, regardless of their identity.



BiM strongly believe that no one should feel ashamed of talking about their feelings, asking for help when they're feeling down or struggling and being themselves.
