Toy Appeal: A reminder we're collecting new or very good condition second-hand teddies.

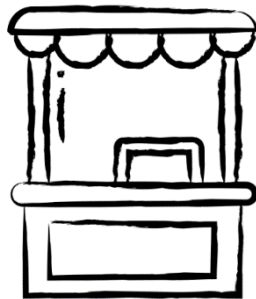
